Core Design

- No gender. Meaning is carried by cases and particles.
- German-like syntax: V2 in main clauses; verb-final in subordinates.
- Spanish-like TAM richness: expressed with particles (not heavy conjugation).
- Emotion is grammatical: emotion particles can modify intent/truth conditions.

Phonology & Orthography (default)

- Vowels: a e i o u
- Consonants (core): m ñ, l r, v s z, š, h, p b, t d, k g, f, j
- Stress: penultimate syllable of the phonological word; particles unstressed.

Word Formation

Head-final compounding: the **last root** is the semantic head.

- **te-log** = truth-reason = proof / theorem-iš
- sae-mu = sorrow-memory = mourning/nostalgia nuance
- an-ßo-mi = love-bind-meaning = vow/affective bondword

Category hints by head:

- ends in **es** states/being; **ki** actions; **mi** meaning/symbol
- ends in log reasoning/system; flo bonds/relations
- ends in **set** collectives; **ord** sequences/order

Compression (historical erosion): frequent compounds may sorten over time (dialects).

Core Syntax

Main clauses (V2):

Exactly one element is fronted; finite verb is **second**.

• nuu ja vi-te ri

Now I witness it.

- an ja vi-te ri
- Lovingly, I witness it.
- mu-sae-in ja vi-te ri Within sorrow-memory, I witness it.

Subordinate clauses (verb-final):

A subordinator triggers verb-last order.

Questions

No inversion. Use \mathbf{qe} (uncertainty) as interrogative mood/marker.

 $\bullet \quad qe \ tu \ vi\hbox{-}te$

- Do you see the truth?
- qe pos we ßo-sol
- Will we bind the vow?

Negation & Polarity

Negator: **na**. Only one negator per clause (unless poetic/paradox).

- Clause negation: ja na vi-te I do not see truth.
- Constituent negation: *ja vi na-te* I see not-truth (falsehood).

Strong affirmation: front te (truth).

• te ja vi

Truly, I see.

TAM: Mood-Tense-Aspect Order (Sacred)

Order is strict: [MOOD] [TENSE] [ASPECT] VERB

Tense (Spanish-like)

Ø present

pra past (preterite/completed)dur-pra imperfect past (ongoing then)

pos future

pos-pra conditional (would)
ret-pra perfect (have done)

Aspect

pun punctual/instant

dur continuous

vek change-of-state / become

ret iterative/again

Mood

 \emptyset indicative (reality)

qe subjunctive / uncertain / imagined

dar imperative / mustfre permissive / may

ve awe/fear mood (reverent)

an loving volition / benevolent intent

TAM Examples

• $ja\ vi$ -te I witness / I see truth.

• ja pra vi-te I witnessed.

• *ja dur-pra vi-te* I was witnessing.

ja pos vi-te
 I will witness.

• ja pos-pra vi-te I would witness.

• *ja ret-pra vi-te* I have witnessed.

• qe pos ja vi-te That I might see.

• dar ki Act.

• $te ext{-}log ext{-}eta o$ by means of proof

• mu-sae-in within sorrow-memory

ullet $ja ext{-}we$ with me

ullet an-na without love / lovelessly

Pronouns (minimal)

ja I / speaker-self

tu you (context decides sg/pl)

we we / collective

un one / generic agent / self

du other / counterpart / they (contextual)

Pronouns decline like nouns: ja-ri (me), tu-ha (to you), etc.

Pro-drop: omit pronouns when obvious.

Registers

- **High Ordic:** no pronouns; timeless; strict order; cannot casually lie.
- Middle Ordic: administration/ritual; compressed compounds; partial erosion.
- Low Ordic: living speech; particles drop; emotion leaks; slang emerges.

Performatives (speech that acts)

Performative classes (core roots):

• Binding: Bo (e.g., an Bo-sol vow bound in love)

• Release: ša + gra (e.g., $gra \, \check{s}a - \beta o \, mercy \, unbinds)$

• Naming: so-mi-es (meaning spoken into being)

• Exile: ex-ord (placed outside order)

• Witness: vi-te (truth-locking)

Selected Root Clusters (for quick building)

Ontology: es (be), na (not/absence), un (one), du (other), al (all), par (part), ka (form), il (essence)

Time: nuu (now), pra (before/past), pos (after/future), dur (duration), pun (instant), ret (again/return), sim (while), vek (become)

Space: in (inside), ex (outside), su (above), da (below), tri (through), ne (near), far (far), lin (path/toward)

Force: ki (do), se (allow), ta (cause), vu (resist), ha (give), ri (take), ßo (bind), ša (sever)

Mind: me (mind), vi (see), lu (know), mu (remember), qe (doubt), so (say), te (truth), mi (meaning)

Emotion: an (love), ir (anger), sae (sorrow), jo (joy), ve (awe/fear), šael (calm), ru (desire), ny (šame)

Social: we (we), tu (you), ja (I), dar (must), fre (may), sol (vow), jur (law), gra (grace)

Quick Build Recipes

- **Proof/theorem:** te-log (truth-reason)
- Witness/verify: vi-te (see-truth)

- Nostalgia: mu-sae (memory-sorrow)
- Bonded promise: an-ßo-sol (love-bind-vow)
- Exile state: ex-ord (outside-order)
- System/order-of-sets: set-ord / ord-set (choose head for nuance)

Ord-Gate (artifact) Activation

A canonical access utterance:

- ullet $gra \; eta o \; we \; ord$ Mercy binds the collective order.
- Constraints: no coercive mood (dar kills it), sincerity required.

ša-te (artifact) Summary

- Weapon inscription: $te\ vi\ \check{s}a$ Truth witnessed through severance.
- Refuses unjustified force; may render wielder unable to use te if abused.

Notes: This sheet assumes particle-based morphology; dialectal erosion can shorten compounds and drop particles in Low Ordic.
