A traveler's tongue.

1) Sound & Pronunciation

Vibe: cold, clipped, corridor-friendly. Stress usually on the 2nd syllable.

Common consonants: v z k g r n l s š t d m

Vowels: a e i o u (long: aa ii uu).

Syllables: (C)(C)V(C).

Example: zulkaíven zul-kah-EE-ven.

2) Core Grammar

Default word order: SOV (Subject-Object-Verb).

Negation: nai placed near the verb.

Cases (suffixes)

Suffix	Meaning / Use
- Ø	subject (no marking)
-un	direct object
-ir	from
-ar	toward / to
-eš	in / within
-ka	with (neutral, incidental)

Two kinds of "with"

- -ka = neutral "with" (incidental): tika with you
- 'kai = bonded "with" (my chosen): ti'kai with you (bonded)

Plural + Possessive

Plural: -im (countable): kordim tools.

Possessive clitics: -em my, -et your, -es their. Examples: vaskem my ship, kaívet your chosen.

Connectors

kur = because; šaen = but/however; tovaš = enough/stop.

5) Particles

- $\mathbf{eh} = \text{question marker (sentence-final)}$
- na = softener ("easy / don't panic")
- **sha** = emphasis ("this matters")
- ...zul. = resignation tone-tag
- ...sáli. = defiant hope tone-tag

6) Evidentials

Sentence-final markers (especially in logs):

- -ser = I saw / verified
- -vem = I heard / reported
- -tov = I infer / it follows
- **-reln** = fold-dream / seam-knowledge (unreliable)

7) Word Formation

Pattern: root + root + suffix.

- Suffixes:
- -ar place/thing (relnar fold-gate/place)
- -i abstract state (druni dread-as-state)
- -um collective (kaium "the chosen (group)")

• -en agent/person (vasken ship-keeper/pilot)

• -eth knowledge/skill/role (relneth foldcraft/seam-

Cultural compounding rules (stylistic):

- Grim/void concepts often start with **zul-**.
- kai sits "near the heart" (often middle) in relational compounds.
- Place-things tend to end with -ar.
