

# Veyruun — Cheat Sheet (v0.1)

*A traveler's tongue.*

## 1) Sound & Pronunciation

**Vibe:** cold, clipped, corridor-friendly. Stress usually on the **2nd syllable**.

**Common consonants:** v z k g r n l s š t d m

**Vowels:** a e i o u (long: aa ii uu).

**Syllables:** (C)(C)V(C).

**Example:** **zulkaíven** *zul-kah-EE-ven*.

## 2) Core Grammar

**Default word order:** SOV (Subject–Object–Verb).

**Negation:** **nai** placed near the verb.

### Cases (suffixes)

Suffix	Meaning / Use
-∅	subject (no marking)
-un	direct object
-ir	from
-ar	toward / to
-eš	in / within
-ka	with (neutral, incidental)

### Two kinds of "with"

- **-ka** = neutral "with" (incidental): **tika** with you
- **'kai** = bonded "with" (my chosen): **ti'kai** with you (bonded)

### Plural + Possessive

**Plural:** **-im** (countable): **kordim** tools.

**Possessive clitics:** **-em** my, **-et** your, **-es** their.

Examples: **vaskem** my ship, **kaívet** your chosen.

### Connectors

**kur** = because; **šaen** = but/however; **tovaš** = enough/stop.

## 3) Pronouns

Form	Meaning
<b>za</b>	I / me
<b>ti</b>	you (sing.)
<b>se</b>	they (sing./unknown)
<b>zan</b>	we (neutral)
<b>zan'kai</b>	we (bonded, chosen company)
<b>tir</b>	you (plural)

## 4) Verbs (Tense, Mood, Aspect)

**Tense suffixes:** **-ta** past, **-ša** ongoing, **-ra** future.

**Mood:** **-m** imperative, **-n** conditional ("would/if").

**Negation:** **nai** (particle) near the verb.

### Mini-conjugation (verb root **ven** "cross")

Form	Meaning
<b>venta</b>	crossed
<b>venša</b>	is crossing
<b>venra</b>	will cross
<b>venm</b>	Cross! / Jump!
<b>venran</b>	would cross / if (we) cross
<b>venša nai</b>	is not crossing

## 5) Particles

- **eh** = question marker (sentence-final)
- **na** = softener ("easy / don't panic")
- **sha** = emphasis ("this matters")
- **...zul.** = resignation tone-tag
- **...sáli.** = defiant hope tone-tag

## 6) Evidentials

Sentence-final markers (especially in logs):

- **-ser** = I saw / verified
- **-vem** = I heard / reported
- **-tov** = I infer / it follows
- **-reln** = fold-dream / seam-knowledge (unreliable)

## 7) Word Formation

**Pattern:** root + root + suffix.

**Suffixes:**

- **-en** agent/person (**vasken** ship-keeper/pilot)
- **-ar** place/thing (**relnar** fold-gate/place)
- **-i** abstract state (**druni** dread-as-state)
- **-um** collective (**kaium** "the chosen (group)")
- **-eth** knowledge/skill/role (**relneth** foldcraft/seam-sense)

**Cultural compounding rules (stylistic):**

- Grim/void concepts often start with **zul-**.
- **kai** sits "near the heart" (often middle) in relational compounds.
- Place-things tend to end with **-ar**.

## 8) Core Roots

Root	Meaning
<b>zul</b>	indifferent void / cosmic uncaring
<b>reln</b>	fold seam (between dimensions)
<b>ven</b>	cross a threshold (space/dimension/fate-line)
<b>kai</b>	chosen companion (bonded)
<b>sáli</b>	stubborn defiant hope-light
<b>drun</b>	dread / weight of meaninglessness
<b>nér</b>	star (as waypoint)
<b>vask</b>	ship/vessel
<b>kath</b>	oath that costs something
<b>hílen</b>	homesick-memory
<b>mór</b>	laughter in the dark
<b>tovar</b>	story-thread / chosen route

## 9) Keystone Words

- **zulkaíven** = crossing the void with the chosen
- **kérunkaí** = made-meaning through the chosen
- **tovaršur** = endure by keeping the story-thread

## 11) Everyday Lexicon

**Verbs:** **som** sleep; **vak** wake; **dun** eat; **šin** drink; **kor** fix/work; **tal** rest; **vul** speak; **heš** listen; **dar** want; **keth** hold/keep; **lir** give; **sok** take; **vren** lie; **sair** tell truth/align speech.

**Nouns:** **kord** tool; **keš** wire/line; **bol** hatch/door; **siv** lock/seal; **rask** fuel; **zeth** air/oxygen; **mek** food; **šin** water/drink; **šav** med/patch; **tarn** credits/tokens; **prax** trade/deal; **tor** light; **vek** dark; **aš** heat; **vyr** cold.

### Greetings

**Relneth eh?**

“You been through the folds?”

**Relneth.**

“I have.”

**Zan’kai eh?**

“Are we bonded?”

### Void + hope

**Zul ker nai. Kai ker ve.**

“The void has no meaning. The chosen do.”

**Kérun ve.**

“Meaning is made.”

**Zan’kai ven-ra, sáli.**

“We will cross together—defiance.”

### Ship ops / emergencies

**Bol sivm!**

“Seal the hatch!”

**Zeth nai!**

“No air!”

**Rask nai, kur kor-ša.**

“No fuel, because we’re fixing it.”

**Tor lirm.**

“Give me the light.”

**Ren na.**

“Breathe. Easy.”

### Bond / intimacy

**Ti hílen ve.**

“You are home.”

**Ti’kai kethm.**

“Stay with me (bonded).”

**Za ti’kai venra.**

“I’ll cross with you.”

### Truth / lies

**Sair-ser.**

“Truth—I saw it.”

**Sair-vem.**

“True (reported).”

**Vren nai.**

“No lies.”

### Insults

**Zulkai.**

“Void-bond.”

**Zulnér.**

“Directionless / faithless.”

**Kai ker nai.**

“You have no chosen.”

### Jump Chant

**Zul nai. Reln ve. Zan’kai ven.**

“Not the void. The seam is. We cross together.”

## 13) A tiny dialogue

**Ti relneth eh?**

“You been through?”

**Relneth. Druni.**

“Yes. Dread remains.”

**Zan’kai?**

“We bonded?”

**Zan’kai. Zulkaíven sáli.**

“We are. Together hope.”

**Venm.**

“Jump.”

heš	to listen
dar	to want / desire
lir	to give
sok	to take
vren	to lie (intentionally)
sair	to tell truth / align words with reality

Noun	Translation
naš	hand / grip
sen	skin / surface (also "hull")
mur	mouth
ren	breath
tor	light (practical light, not "hope-light")
vek	dark
aš	heat
vyr	cold
kord	tool
keš	wire / line / cable
bol	door / hatch
siv	lock / seal
rask	fuel / burn-stuff
zeth	oxygen / air supply
mek	food (generic)
šin	water / drink (noun+verb)
šav	med / patch / first aid
tarn	money / credits (literally "tokens")
prax	trade / deal
vekra	night cycle / "ship-night"
